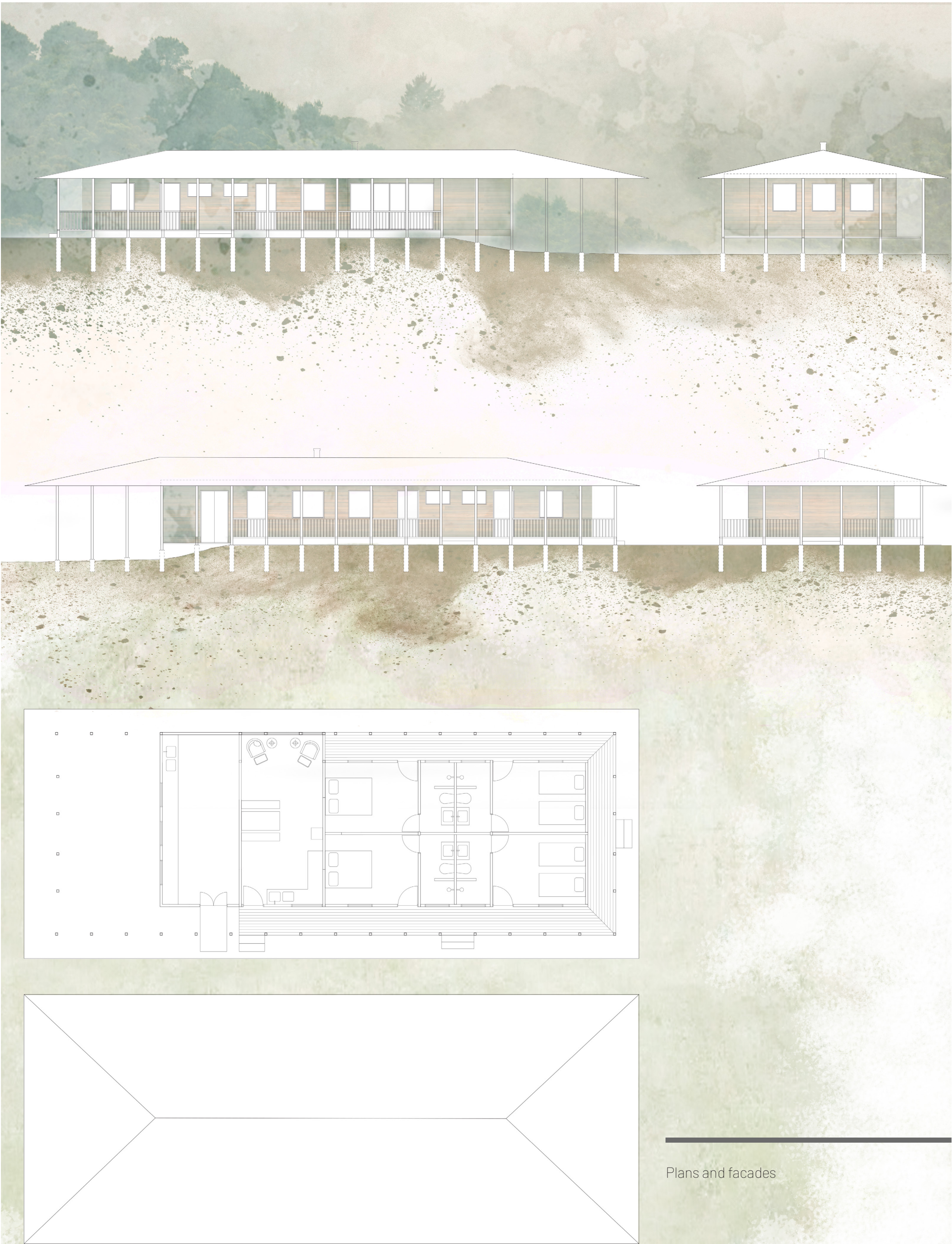

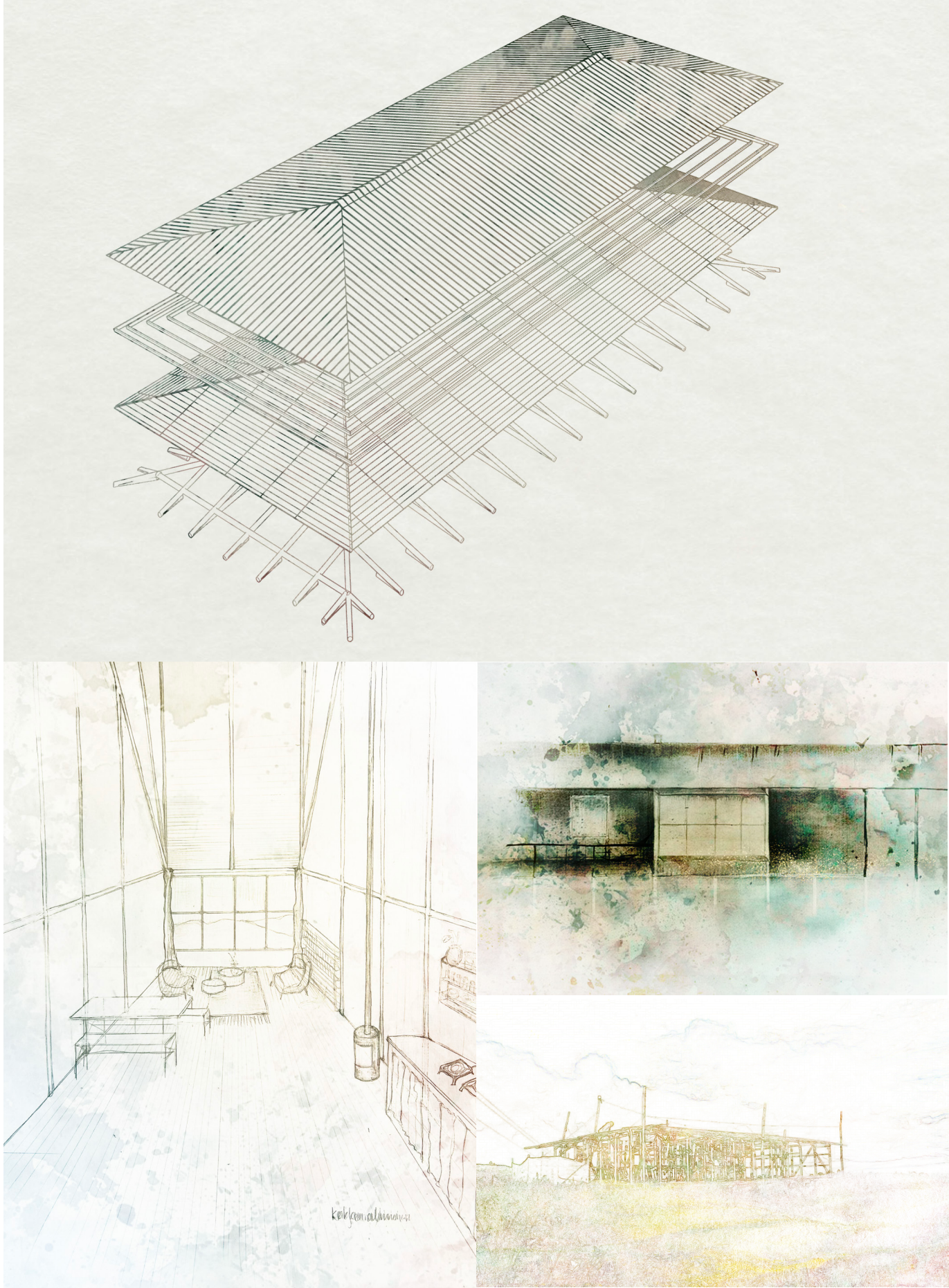
ARCHITECTURAL PROJECT 2025  
Building process is ongoing

WILD Campo Alegre (WCA) is a Danish-led biodiversity and nature conservation project located in the high Andean cloud forests of Colombia. Founded in December 2022 by the WILD Nature Foundation (WNF), the project aims to protect and restore one of the most threatened and biodiverse ecosystems on the planet. The building is part of base camp facility in order to accomodate forest rangers guarding the conser-

vancy. The building is constructed in traditional methods, partially with reclaimed wood from abandoned fincas (farms) from the land of the conservancy.
